

Latest Vacancies

Our fortnightly swim session is on a Saturday evening 6pm till 7.15, so if you have 75mins to spare up to 22 times a year, please get in touch. Our current vacancies are as follows:

Front Desk Assistant (reception) x 2

In summary, the Front Desk Assistant's role is to support the Board of Trustees by running the front desk/reception area on a swim night, welcoming members, taking payments, orders and ensuring each member is recorded in the attendance register at the start of each session.

Assistant Coach* (poolside and in water) x 3

In summary, the Assistant Coach's role is to support the Coaches by delivering session activities and games, may this be on a one to one or group basis. To assist in the delivery of SDSG's reward schemes with the aim of supporting all members to achieve the best they can.

Hoist Operator x2

In summary, the Hoist Operators role is to undertake the safe transportation of hoist users from poolside to the water. To set up the pool equipment at the start of each session and ensure it is safely put away in partnership with the coaches. They also take a vital role in being the eye and ears on poolside, allocating equipment and alerting Lifeguards and the Poolside Team Leader to situations as they emerge.

General Volunteer / Helper x 3

In summary, the General Volunteer's role is to support The Board Of Trustees to run a fortnightly swimming session, offering recreational, rehabilitation and swimming for sport, in-addition, to adhoc social events. It is foreseen that volunteers will take on various roles, supporting fellow volunteers and trustees to deliver the charity's aims and objectives. Volunteers are assigned activities / roles depending on experience, skill, the availability of work and the needs of the charity. Often this will involve being a swimming companion in the water, timing swimming's lengths on poolside, allocating equipment and covering the front desk. This role is often an entry position into the group, where you can take on many different roles whilst being supported by more experienced volunteers.

Training and a named supervisor is provided for all roles.
